Monthly Report – April & May 2016

VJNNS releasing the monthly update report with details of the tasks, activities executed by each individual during the mentioned month. During April & May month, we majorly started our activities for the coming financial year 2016 – 17, first by revisiting the old MLPs and then taking up the GFWSS construction work. Few maintenance work such as repairs were also taken care during this month. A new GFWSS was inaugurated at Gutham Village by the MPDO, Sarpanch and Village community members. We also completed our finance auditing by C. R. Rao & Team for 2015 – 16.

CSR Initiatives have been going on in full swing by K. Govinada Rao. In the month of April, he has met 10 new companies and have given presentations on Gravity Fed Water Supply System (GFWSS). The list of companies along with their current status is listed below:-

- JSW:- Waiting for response from senior management
- ROCKLAND:- There is no CSR
- GREENPLAY:- They would be interested for CSR activities pertaining to Environment care by August Month

- VITALAB:- Follow up in coming weeks

Mr. Govinada Rao also met with Rural Water Supply Senior Engineer (RWS SE) and handed over the completed GFWSS construction village list so that the Govt. body is aware of the villages where drinking water system is constructed. He also handed over the World Water Day (WWD) report to the guest participant in Vizag District. He attended the monthly review meeting held at VJNNS office and discussed the above points.

In terms of MLP preparations, our MLP Coordinator, Sanyasi Rao have done a detailed study of already done 8 MLPs. Rechecked the data and did the final consolidation of the MLP reports. Previously done 60 MLP drafts were also uploaded online for data retention. We also met PO – ITDA (Paderu) for update on the status of VJNNS activities and at the same time also submitted 2015 – 16 GFWSS construction village's data.

We had conducted Pre-Construction trainings and have started with GFWSS construction at 3 villages, namely

Training programmes were conducted at Nimmachittu village on best hygiene practices and sanitation by our Training Coordinator R. Ganesh. A total of 37 members attended the programme out of which 22 were female and 15 were male. Another village had a training programme at our partner NGO village Thotapalli and 10 members attended the meeting. Same village during the discussion came up with the replacement of filter media as



maintenance work was pending. VJNNS initiated the filter media replacement and 10 men came out for the shramadaan. All the activities were logged in the muster roll and 5 different village's muster roll from partner NGOs were collected & submitted in the VJNNS office.

Organized villages level trainings on WASH and 14 points & 7 components to the community for 4 villages namely Kinnamguda (TCDS), Gathum (TERDS), Nondrukona (Jattu), Girijana Vikas (Nimmachettu) of Partner NGO's GFWSS constructed area.

There was some repair work which had taken place. At Baddimetta village, pipelines were damaged by a JCB heavy vehicle while some digging work and complete repair work carried out. A review meeting was conducted at Nondrukona village and there was some repair work for the distribution tank along with the social audit board. All the fixes were done by the villagers with the assistance from VJNNS. 5 villages had repair work reported on the social audit board. During the MLP revisits these repairs were completed.

Doddikonda village there was some stand post not working, so the team repaired it and also made small canal way for the water outflow to the nearby garden. Pentapadu village also needed some stand post tap repair which was also repaired with help from our field coordinator V. L. Padal. A lot of saplings were planted at the source tank of Madem, Doddikonda, V. Kothuru Singnapalli and Damanapalli. We also visited 3 villages (Suravaram, Govada, Chithamamidi) to check on the saplings that were planted few months back. In terms of getting more saplings, we wrote letters and submitted at the Divisional Forest Officer (DFO), also submitted letter to Associate Professional Officers (APOs) at Chintapalli Village and got it signed for further saplings.

Our Women Coordinator from the partner NGO met with Municipal Vice-Chairman & Commissioner for building a stitching center for the women to carry on small scale business. We also initiated the development talks with Government officials for providing safe drinking water units at Kala Priyadarshini Mahila Nava Nirmana Samithi. Conducted and Attended Gramasabha at Suddagaruvu village.

We have a group of students from reputed Azim Premji University who have come down to Narsipatnam for comparative study of GFWSS with other alternative water facilities in the villages. A detailed reported will be submitted to our Donor Agency Arghyam. A team from Arghyam also visited VJNNS operational areas to observe on the development of construction.
